This award recognizes Jack Webster and his legacy of insightful, accurate and uncompromising reporting from his more than 40 years of print, radio and television journalism.

Eligibility:

- Students are eligible who are permanent residents of British Columbia (at least three years) and who are pursuing full time journalism studies in one of these BC post-secondary journalism programs: BCIT, Langara College, Kwantlen University College, Thompson Rivers University, University of British Columbia.
- An eligible applicant is a student who is in a senior year in one of the above journalism programs and who preferably has practical or volunteer experience in the journalism field. A student may also be eligible if he or she holds a postsecondary degree and is in one of the above programs. Generally speaking, a student who has moved from high school into a journalism program will not be eligible until he or she has more experience. To be considered, a student must be attending the 2011 fall and 2012 spring terms.

Awards:

- Six \$2,000 are available and will be paid towards tuition to the recipient's school.
- Recipients will join the awards sponsors at the Jack Webster Awards Dinner on October 24, 2011.

- A 500-word essay describing:
 - o Your views on the place of journalism in the world we live
 - o Why you chose journalism as a career
 - o Your career goals
- Your resumé
